TWO VISITING ASSISTANT PROFESSOR POSITIONS

The **Department of Psychology** at **Lafayette College** invites applications for two one-year Visiting Assistant Professor positions beginning Fall 2010. Applicants must have a Ph.D. in a relevant field and experience teaching undergraduate students. We seek applicants with the ability to teach introductory psychology with laboratory, quantitative methods and research design, in addition to the courses in the specialty areas listed below. The first position is in **Social Psychology**. Applicants for this position should be able to teach courses in Social Behavior and Advanced Social Psychology with laboratory. The second position is in **Experimental Psychology**, with preference given to candidates who can teach courses in Sensation and Perception and who can contribute to the Neuroscience program. Willingness to involve undergraduate students in research and/or to mentor them in independent scholarship is a plus for both positions. Lafayette College is a highly selective private undergraduate college with academic programs and opportunities characteristic of larger institutions. The College is approximately 70 miles from both NYC and Philadelphia.
